Our Social Mission:

The project serves the underprivileged children who have limited access to English storybooks and reading opportunity at home.

Student Learning:

Students will learn about the development of educational activities and assessment tools for real case situations, and applying to the teaching platforms other than primary schools.

Project Opportunities:

- Visit schools and community centers to conduct storytelling sessions for children in small groups.
- Study and assess the current teaching materials and session planning.
- Investigate the beneficiaries' literacy skills.
- Develop and improve the learning curriculum.
- Implement the improved learning curriculum.
- Set a tool to measure the impact brought by the improved curriculum.
- Report the findings.
